STUDENT EXPECTATIONS
INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL STUDENTS WRITING EXAMS:

1. Students are expected to be on time for the exam with their required materials to write the exam. Check this schedule very carefully.
2. Students will raise their hand if they need assistance from a teacher.
3. Students are NOT allowed to talk or try to communicate with other students in the exam room. Turn all cell phones OFF and leave all materials not necessary for the exam at the back of the gymnasium.
4. Students are expected not to cheat on the exam. If caught, they will be asked to leave the examination area and go to the office.
5. Students returning texts or novels at the end of their course should return them as directed by the subject teacher. Jackets, scribblers, binders, etc., should be left in the lockers.
6. Students are expected to sit quietly when they finish writing until the minimum time is up (10:30 am OR 2:00 pm).
7. Students are expected to stay home on days they do not write an exam.
8. If a student is absent for an exam, he/she will need a medical excuse in order to be able to write at a later date. Parents should phone the school (275-2700) if their son/daughter is ill and unable to write the exam that day.
9. In the event of school closure occur, the exams that were to be written on that day will be written on the next day back to school and the entire schedule will shift by one day.
