- 2 Verification by school of scholastic achievement of a standard acceptable for University entrance. [optional--- copy of university acceptance letter]
- 3 Evidence provided of the applicant's interest and active participation in Extracurricular activities such as drama, sports, public speaking, debating, student travel, literary contests, student exchange programs, student government or student organizations providing for the development of leadership qualities.
- 4 Evidence provided by teacher or member of the community at large of the Applicant's involvement in community programs or youth organizations
- 5 Agreeable to posing with a representative of the Lodge for a publicity picture.
